
ROTARY - DISTRICT 5340 - MEMBERSHIP NEWSLETTER - SEPTEMBER 2011

I think you can see why Membership has to be a focus year round. If you wait too long, you are going to dig yourself a hole very quickly. A 100 member club loses over a member a month. <u>RETENTION</u> is key just to maintain you club.

September is New Generations month where Rotarians focus on youth. On a <u>RECRUITING</u> level this is a big opportunity to introduce Rotary to our future leaders. They will remember what Rotary did for them and, when they are ready, will seek Rotary out. The youth also have another connection that can provide new members, their parents! With all of the great programs we do, we have to consider asking their parents to check Rotary out. Consider all that you can do with parents of your Interact Club, LEAD, scholarship recipients, and RYLA youth.

You can also use New Generations Month to <u>REINVIGORATE</u> your club through youth. Ask young people to attend your club meeting, with their parents. Bring your membership to LEAD or to an Interact meeting. Let your members see the great energy of today's youth. Harness that energy and infuse your club.
